BY-LAW REGARDING THE DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS PROVIDED UNDER THE ACT RESPECTING THE AUTORITÉ DES MARCHÉS PUBLICS

**CONSIDERING THAT** Bill nº 108 *An Act to facilitate oversight of public bodies' contracts and to establish the Autorité des marches publics* (L.Q. 2017, c. 27) was adopted and assented to on December 1, 2017;

**WHEREAS** following such sanction and in conformity with section 33, 45, 54, 59 of an *Act respecting the Autorité des marchés publics* (CQLR, c. A-33.2.1) (the "Act"), Council of a municipal body may delegate all or part of the functions assigned to it under the Act to the Director general of the municipality;

**WHEREAS** a presentation and a notice of motion of the present by-law were given at the regular Council meeting held on November 18, 2019:

# <u>SECTION 1</u> AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT OBSERVATIONS TO AND RECEIVE RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE AUTORITÉ DES MARCHÉS PUBLICS

1.1 The authorization to submit observations to and receive recommendations from the Autorité des marchés publics on behalf of the City pursuant to the *Act respecting the Autorité des marchés publics* is delegated to the director general.
