Ash tree felling rules


- Any felled ash tree must be replaced
- Any dead ash tree must be felled within 6 months

Calendar

From May 31 until September 1

• No pruning or cutting in order to prevent the spread of infection

An ash tree 15 cm or less in diameter at 1.3 m from the ground, may be felled without applying for a permit



No charge for permit Time period: within 60 days Time extended if outside of the permitted period
