11,000 ASH TREES THREATENED

The emerald ash borer is an Asian insect that has devastated a large part of North America's ash trees in less than 15 years; it has now reached Beaconsfield. Trees need to be treated every two years with TreeAzin which must be applied by certified personnel.

Example - every second year

Tree 42 cm x \$3.35 \$140.70

The average cost for felling a tree, including grubbing and replacement: **\$1,600**

Treatment is not guaranteed.

Ash tree felling rules

- Permit issued on-site, free
- Permitted number: 4 per year, or 1/4 of ash trees if over 10 trees
- Debarking of two branch sections by the inspector following felling

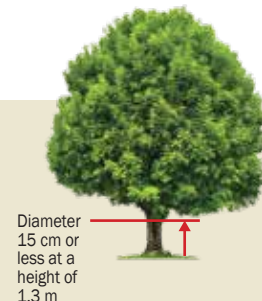
Calendar

From May 31 until September 1

- No pruning or cutting in order to prevent the spread of infection

EXCEPTION

An ash tree 15 cm or less in diameter at 1.3 m from the ground, may be felled without applying for a permit



Diameter 15 cm or less at a height of 1.3 m

75 AREAS DETECTED IN OUR COMMUNITY

Quarantine zone

Any ash located within 100 m of an infested ash is quarantined and must be treated or felled.

No charge for permit

Time period: within 60 days

Time extended if outside of the permitted period
