The City offers many options to help you dispose of your waste responsibly.

REUSE	Used items in good condition	Collection bins at the Beaconsfield Shopping Center, Elm Plaza, convenience stores, and the Renaissance store. For used furniture in good condition, call West Island Assistance Fund or Salvation Army for free pick-up.
RECYCLE	Recyclable materials	Once per week, on Thursdays
	Electronic waste	Bring your e-waste to Public Works (300 Beaurepaire).
	Construction, renovation and demolition waste	Residents are allowed free five drop-offs per year. The container is located behind the Public Works building.
	Hazardous waste (e.g. paints, batteries, cleaning products)	Two weekend hazardous waste collection in the spring and in the fall Check out the CONTACT magazine or visit our website at beaconsfield.ca for dates
	Metallic bulky waste	Free pick-up by contacting Public Works
	Special pick-up	Special pick-up can be organized by contacting Public Works (\$95 minimum).
ENHANCE THE VALUE OF ORGANIC MATTER	Kitchen and yard residue	Those organic matters can be composted in a backyard composter.
	Leaf and yard residue	Collection dates in the spring and in the fall Next collection dates: Mondays on October 20 and 27, and November 3, 10 and 17 Use reusable containers or compostable paper bags. No plastic bags will be picked up.
	Branches	Two spring collection dates by sector and two fall collection dates by sector Check out the CONTACT magazine or visit our website at beaconsfield.ca for dates
LANDFILL	Garbage collection	Once per week, on Thursdays
