WHAT SHOULD YOU DO AFTER REGISTERING?

Notify your contact persons of your registration

- In an emergency situation, we will call your emergency contact person(s) if we are unable to reach you
- It is best to notify them in advance as it can be stressful to receive a call from us without warning
- Show them this pamphlet
- If possible, use a neighbour as a contact person

Prepare an emergency survival kit

- This kit will help you to be self-sufficient for 72 hours

Notify us of any change in situation

- Moving
- Prolonged vacation
- Your health in general

WHICH SERVICES WILL BE OFFERED?

- We will call twice a year to update our records (November and May)
- We will call in case of emergency (heat wave, storm, prolonged power outage, etc.)
- We will call in case of a major issue with city equipment (aqueduct, etc.), that directly affects your home
- If we are unable to reach you, Municipal Patrol will pay you a visit

WHAT SHOULD YOUR 72 HOUR EMERGENCY SURVIVAL KIT CONTAIN?

- Drinking water (2 L per day, per person)
- Non-perishable food
- Manual can opener
- Lighter or matches and candles
- Flashlight or head lamp
- First-aid kit
- Blanket
- Battery-powered or wind-up radio
- Whistle
- Medication
- Cash

24 hours a day, 7 days a week
