

EXTRACT from the minutes of the Assembly on June 12, 2000 of Beaconsfield's Municipal Council meeting, held in City Hall, 303, Beaconsfield Boulevard, Beaconsfield, Quebec, at 20h.

2000-06-208 Twinning project with City of Verneuil-sur-Seine in France

WHERAS the city of Verneuil-sur-Seine, in France has unfortunately suffered a climatic disaster in 1999, such as Beaconsfield has encountered in 1998.

WHERAS the similarities which exist between the City of Verneuil-sur-Seine and the City of Beaconsfield, Québec, Canada, i.e.:

- Verneuil-sur-Seine is located 25 minutes from Paris and Beaconsfield is located 25 minute from Montreal, two large cities;
- The City of Verneuil-sur-Seine values its wooden areas and its nautical activities and Beaconsfield, a waterfront city on Lake St. Louis, considers itself "a town and country lifestyle" with its tens of thousands of trees of different types;
- Verneuil-sur-Seine is essentially a residential city, oriented toward family, just like Beaconsfield

It was moved by Councillor E.A. Dahl, seconded by Councillor A.M. Parent and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that the Beaconsfield Municipal Council, inform the city of Verneuil-sur-Seine, of its interest to establish some relations, which could eventually lead to twin our two municipalities.

Furthermore, after having lived the same experience and to demonstrate our sympathy towards a city which has lived the same trauma, the City of Beaconsfield wishes to donate to the City of Verneuil-sur-Seine, trees to replace some which were destroyed during the disaster. To this effect, we are pleased to enclose our cheque in the amount of 5,000 francs.
