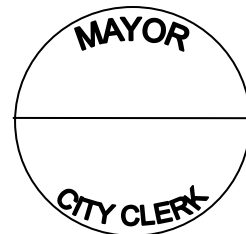

**BY-LAW PERTAINING TO THE TERMS OF PUBLICATION OF PUBLIC NOTICES  
OF THE CITY OF BEACONSFIELD**

At the regular meeting of the Council of the City of Beaconsfield, held at City Hall, 303 Beaconsfield Boulevard, Beaconsfield, Quebec, on December 17, 2018, at 8 p.m.

WERE PRESENT: His Honour the Mayor Georges Bourelle, Councillors Dominique Godin, Karen Messier, Robert Mercuri, David Newell, Roger Moss and Al Gardner

**WHEREAS** in accordance with section 345.1 of the *Cities and Towns Act* (CQLR, c. C-19), a municipality may, by by-law, determine the terms governing publication of its public notices;

**WHEREAS** it is deemed appropriate that Council adopt a by-law to that effect;

**WHEREAS** a draft by-law was filed and a notice of motion was given at the Council's regular meeting, held on November 19, 2018, at 8 p.m.

On motion of Councillor K. Messier, seconded by Councillor A. Gardner and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED:

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACONSFIELD ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:**

**SECTION 1    APPLICABILITY**

The present by-law shall apply to all public notices prescribed by a provision of the *Cities and Towns Act*, other general or special Act, or by regulations governing the City of Beaconsfield.

**SECTION 2    PUBLICATION**

The City must publish its public notices in a section provided for to that effect on its Website.

**SECTION 3    POSTING AND TRANSMISSION BY ELECTRONIC MEANS FOR INFORMATION PURPOSES**

In addition to the terms of publication stated in Section 2 and for information purposes only, the City reserves the right to post as follows:

- 1) on bulletin boards at City Hall, the Recreation Centre and at the Public Works;
- 2) by email to the residents, owners or merchants registered to its electronic mailing service.

**SECTION 4    PRECEDENCE**

The present by-law has precedence over the mode of publication prescribed by section 345 of the *Cities and Towns Act*.

**SECTION 5    DURATION OF PUBLICATION**

All public notices must remain published on the City's Website for a minimum period of fourteen (14) days from the date of its publication.

**SECTION 6    COMING INTO FORCE**

This by-law comes into force according to law and comes into effect on January 1, 2019.
