WHEREAS a draft by-law was filed and a notice of motion of this By-law BEAC-045-21 entitled "By-law modifying By-law BEAC-045 on permits and certificates to amend the term "wood-burning system" " was adopted at the regular Council meeting on Monday, XXX, 2025;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACONSFIELD ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 1: Paragraph 3.2.1 m) is replaced by the following:

3.2.1. Issuance of a certificate of authorization

Unless a certificate of authorization has been issued, no one shall begin or continue the following types of work:

(...)

m) Install a certified solid fuel appliance in accordance with By-law BEAC-170 regarding solid fuel appliances and fireplaces;

This by-law shall come into force according to law.
