BY-LAW MODIFYING BY-LAW BEAC-029 REGARDING BUDGET CONTROL AND
MONITORING IN ORDER TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE BY-LAW ON THE
DELEGATION OF POWERS TO THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF
BEACONSFIELD

At the regular meeting of the Municipal Council of the City of Beaconsfield, held at City Hall, 303 Beaconsfield Boulevard, Beaconsfield, Quebec, on DAY MONTH, 202X, at 7:30 p.m.

WERE PRESENT: Mr. Mayor Martin St-Jean and Councillors Dominique Godin, Marie Léveillé, Robert Mercuri, David Newell, Jason Rossie and Tim Quinn

WHEREAS a draft by-law was filed and a notice of motion of this by-law was given at the regular Council meeting on XXX, 20XX;

On motion of Councillor XXXXXXXX XXXXXX, seconded by Councillor XXXXXXXX XXXXXX and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED:

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEACONSFIELD ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

Section 1 Section 19 of By-law BEAC-029 is replaced by the following :

“19. Certain expenditures of a particular nature are time mandated and difficult to control beforehand. They must, however, like all expenditures, be controlled thereafter and have a budgetary monitoring. The expenditures listed in section 4.1 of By-law BEAC-082 on the delegation of powers to the officers and employees of the City of Beaconsfield are paid upon receipt of the invoice, supporting documents, or legal documents substantiating such expenses.”

Section 2 L'article 22 du Règlement BEAC-029 est remplacé par le suivant :

“22. As prescribed by section 105.4 of the Cities and Towns Act, the Treasurer shall table at a Council meeting two (2) comparative statements regarding the City’s revenues and expenditures.”

Section 3 Coming into force

This by-law comes into force in accordance with law.
