The City does not provide a bin for the collection of organic material.

Green and food residue may be mixed together on condition that it is put in a bin with a lid.

GREEN RESIDUE

Green residue : Leaves, grass clippings, flowers, plants, weeds, hedge trimmings. See complete list at beaconsfield.ca.
 Place green residue in cardboard boxes, bins or paper bags.

FOOD RESIDUE


Food residue: Fruits, vegetables, meats, fish, dairy products, bread, cereal. See complete list at beaconsfield.ca. Place food residue in a bin (40 L or more) with a completely closed lid.



REMINDER : NEITHER PLASTIC BAGS OR BLUE BINS, NOR BRANCHES WILL BE COLLECTED.

RECYCLING

Only recyclable materials placed in the blue bin will be collected. The bin cover must be closed.

Printed materials, containers and packaging made of cardboard, paper, plastic, glass and metal are collected: 

Refused Items:

Styrofoam • Wood and construction material • Electronic products • Lightbulbs • Toys • Plastic equipment (hoses, etc.) • Textiles • Green and food residue

GARBAGE

Garbage will not be collected if the grey bin supplied by the City contains recyclable material, green residue, tree residue, bulky items and CRD, tires, dead animals, electronic products, batteries, household hazardous waste and any other non-compliant items.

PROCEDURES FOR ROLLING BINS (RECYCLING AND GARBAGE)



Only bins supplied by the City will be collected. They should be put out by the curb after 5 p.m. the night before, or before 7 a.m. the day of the collection.

Please be sure that:

- Closed bins are placed on your property and spaced at least one metre apart.
Never place the bins on the sidewalk or in the street
- Bin wheels and handles face your house
- Bins are visible and accessible to the operator at all times
- Heavier items are placed at the bottom of the bin

Poorly placed bins will not be emptied.
